Rebecca Agnes Moore, affectionately known as “Agnes” was born November 9, 1931, in Bushnell, Florida to her loving parents Rebecca and Ceasar Moore.

Agnes was the youngest of twelve siblings: five boys and seven girls. She grew up and received her education in the Sumter County Public School System.

Agnes married the love of her life, the late Ezell Allen on August 16, 1947. They were blessed with seven children to this union, three of which preceded them in death: Trudy Carol, Ezell Allen, Jr., and Sigrid Allen-Scott.
