Naomi Eady Hamm, a devoted Christian woman was born on June 15, 1925 in Jennings, Florida. She is the daughter of Reverend Henry Eady and Stepmother Hettie "Missie" Eady. Naomi was the youngest of two siblings and her Stepsister, Adlene Blackshear was the oldest. Naomi attended and graduated from Hungerford Boarding School, under the direction of the late Frank Otey.

At a tender age, Naomi knew about God probably as soon as she could talk; and church was an everyday event in the Eady's home. After the death of her father, the Eady family relocated to Winter Park, Florida and soon began attending Bethel Missionary Baptist Church. At that time, it was customary for Bethel to sponsor weekend tent revivals and one of those nights at a tent revival, Naomi joined Bethel Missionary Baptist Church.

Naomi has been a member of Bethel Missionary Baptist Church for over 50 years. She served as the President of the Senior Mission (represented by her yellow carnation), a member of Choir #2, and also served on other church committees.

On Monday, April 13, 2015, God touched her with His finger and she slept safely in His arms. Through sickness and in health, Naomi was a good and faithful servant and a loving wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother, and friend to many. She lived by her favorite saying, "I love my God and I love my church!"

Naomi was preceded in death by her husband, Johnny Leroy Hamm, daughter, Sheryl Naomi Hamm, parents, Reverend Henry Eady and stepmother, Hettie "Missie" Eady.
