



Nessa Sheila Williams

August 15, 1947 - January 5, 2020

Nessa Sheila Williams was born on August 15th, 1947 in Prospect, Clarendon, Jamaica to Ira Brandford and Doris Lewis. She was also affectionately known as Cutie and was one of four children to both Ira and Doris; however, she has several brothers and sisters born to Ira and Doris separately.

Nessa attended Prospect Primary School, then in later years, was a student at Summerfield Commercial School in Clarendon.

Nessa was reared by her grandparents whom she loved dearly. She frequently told stories of her upbringing, living with her cousins, her life with her siblings, her love and appreciation for the large family, and their love for her. She had lived with her grandparents as her father had immigrated to England, and her mother was rearing her brothers and sisters.

Cutie immigrated to Canada in 1969 with the help of one of her cousins, Chris, whom she loved dearly. In the early 1970s, she sent for Headley Shirley (her first husband), and had her third child Marcia shortly after. Her first two children, Evadne and Radcliffe, immigrated to Canada in 1975. As her choice of career, she provided private home care for the elderly and children. Her clients and employers loved and valued her so much that they kept in touch with her, even after her employment had ended.

In July 1983, Nessa was remarried to Felix Williams. Her granddaughter Vanessa, and daughter Evadne, moved to Pickering, Ontario to be with them. Felix's sons — Everton, Verral, and Junior - who were living in Jamaica soon joined the family. It was in this home that many family members, friends, and acquaintances came for soup, enjoyed a weekend barbecue, received vegetables from Felix's garden, and sometimes stayed to be nursed back to good health. Even after moving to Kissimmee, Florida in 2003, Nessa continued to display the same love and kindness to all visitors in their home.

Her relationship with God was important. After being baptized, she also led Felix to the Lord. While exuding faith, beauty, grace, strength and passion, she was a no-nonsense person - a true Proverbs 31 woman. Attending church service was one of the occasions in which Sheila had the opportunity to look beautiful on the outside as she was on the inside with her coordinated hat, dress, shoes and handbag.

Nessa is survived by her husband, Felix Williams, three children; Evadne (Penny), Radcliffe (Dave), and Marcia, stepchildren; Everton, Junior, Verral, Michael, Angie and Delroy, brothers, sisters, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews, countless cousins, in-laws, a host of extended relatives, and dear friends.

While her earthly journey ended on January 5th, 2020...she lives on in eternity!
