



Deaconess Ozella Ingram Johnson

August 9, 1930 - February 26, 2018

Deaconess Mother Ozella Ingram Johnson was born on August 9, 1930 to Lester and Annie B. Ingram in Edison, Georgia.

She met and married Willie Fred Johnson in December 1948 and to this union (7) seven children were born. At an early age she joined Enon Missionary Baptist Church of Coleman, Georgia, she served there until she and her family moved to Florida in 1952. One year later in 1953, she became a member of Tildenville Missionary Baptist Church in Tildenville, Florida where she served faithfully as a Deaconess, she also served faithfully for 45 years as the president of Choir #1 until the day of her passing.

Mother Ozella was employed by the West Orange County Head Start Program for twenty-eight years until she retired in 1995. Five (5) years later in 2001, she went back to work for ten years with the Orange County Sheriff as a Crossing Guard until November 2010. She has been a long time advocate for the people of the community of Tildenville, Florida, she spent thirty-eight (38) years of being a past matron of Heroines of Jericho.

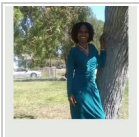
