Pastor Lisa V. Lipsey passed away peacefully in her sleep at her daughter's home on November 29, 2024 amongst family.

Lisa was born in South Bend IN to Frankie Lee Lipsey and Pearlean (Giden) Lipsey on September 19, 1956.

Lisa attended Oliver elementary and Central High School. Lisa graduated from Trinity Baptist College 2011. Lisa was a beautiful child and a spontaneous, fashionable, independent, and adventurous young lady. She left home early to explore the world, she loved to travel. Lisa was a bartender at Cinnabar in the 70's in South Bend IN, and the VFW in South Bend and Milwaukee in the 80s. Lisa was also a member of a pool club, she loved to shoot pool, and she was good at it. Lisa would later become the owner operator of Lisa's Christian Home Care, and Lisa's creations, she loved to bake and cook. Which she was very good at. This was a part of her ministry.

Lisa always had dreams of moving to a bigger city. Lisa moved to California in 1978 and within a year her brother Frankie followed and other siblings as well. Later her daughter joined her in 1979. Lisa eventually moved back to South Bend a few years later. Lisa always had love for her family. Her love showed even more when she found the Lord. Lisa's life changed for the better and she wanted her family and friends to find what she found in the Lord. Pastor Lisa loved to talk about Her father in heave to anyone who would listen. Pastor Lisa loved going to feed the homeless. That was one her ministries under the church, Church of all Nations Deliverance and Healing Ministry. During the winter month she would provide the homeless with socks, clothing, toiletries, food and blankets in Jacksonville, FL.

Pastor Lisa started a Women's Conference four years ago, that she was very proud of. She would reach out to Pastor's from all over to be a part of the conference. Her last conference was in October of 2024, that she couldn't make it because of her health. However, her sister's (Pastor's Apostles and intercessors) in Christ made sure the conference was successful.

Pastor Lisa moved to North Carolina four years ago to follow God's calling to be an associate pastor of a church. After her assignment was over, she stayed in North Carolina to finish her ministry there. Pastor Lisa continued feeding, clothing and providing the necessities to the homeless. She would go to some areas that some were afraid to go, she always said God will cover her as she went out to take care of His people.

Pastor Lisa was diagnosed with ovarian cancer in May of 2022. She went through chemo on two separate occasions. However, the third time when the cancer came back she refused chemo because she said the chemo felt like it was killing her. Pastor Lisa said that her Father in heave would heal her as He sees fit and let His will be done.

Pastor Lisa was preceded in death by her parents, her siblings: Linda Thomas Dorothy Jean Thomas, Kenneth A. Lipsey, Kevin R. Lipsey, Pearlie B. Giden and Shirley Ann Thomas. Her loving granddaughter Tiara "Nuk" Lipsey.

Pastor Lisa is survived by her only child Alisha Lipsey, her siblings: Larry L. Thomas of Seattle WA, Willie F. Lipsey of Durham NC, Alvin M. 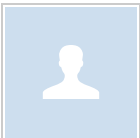
