December 25, 1933 - March 17, 2015

Raymond Conover was born December 25, 1933 in Red Bank, New Jersey. He was the eldest of four children and the only boy to Dora Bolder.

Raymond affectionately known as “Ray” received his formal education at Red Bank Borough Public Schools. Upon graduation from Red Bank High School, he enlisted in the United States Army where he faithfully served for four years receiving an honorable discharge.

Raymond harbored dreams of becoming someone great and his unpolished talents caught the eyes of many. He pursued nature allotted him the opportunity to travel and battle some of New Jersey’s greatest. His numerous awards were evidence that he was one of the most talented boxers of his time to step foot in the ring.
