



## Reverend Dr. Alvin Roosevelt Carr

May 3, 1951 - November 16, 2023

Reverend Alvin Roosevelt Carr was born May 3, 1951 in Washington, D.C. to Reverend Johnie B. and Mary E. Jennings-Carr. He accepted the Lord as his Savior at an early age and joined Buffalo Baptist Church under the leadership of his father the late Rev. Johnie B. Carr. Through his many years at the Buffalo Baptist Church, he sang in the choir, played the piano, and became an ordained minister. He was a faithful member up until he left for Florida.

Alvin was a great singer and with two of his brothers: Thomas and Larry they formed a gospel quartet group called "The Mighty Carr Brothers." They recorded two records and traveled throughout the Washington Metropolitan area.

He earned an AA degree in Physical Education from Federal City College and attended Howard University School of Theology and the Washington Baptist Seminary in D.C. where he earned several other honorary degrees.

In his career, Alvin worked at the U.S. Government Printing Office in D.C., and pastored Zion Hill Missionary Baptist Church and other churches throughout the state of Florida. He worked at various funeral homes as a Funeral Director and in the Public School System as a Physical Education Teacher.

Reverend Dr. Alvin Carr transitioned on November 16, 2023, at the age of 72

after a prolonged health battle at AdventHealth Waterman Hospital, Tavares, Florida.

He was preceded in death by his Parents: Reverend Johnnie B. and Mary E. Jennings-Carr; four Brothers: Isaac, Monroe “Joe”, Reverend Thomas “Sonny” Carr, and Shirley Poindexter; and one Sister: Reverend Vivian Cherry.
