Robert Lewis Lamar, Sr. was born on August 21, 1940 in Byron, Georgia to Mr. Abraham and Mrs. Ella Lamar. He attended school from Elementary to Junior High at Edgewood and graduated from Carver Heights High School in Leesburg, Florida. Robert joined the Army November 11, 1963 and served his country for four years. After returning to civilian life, he became the lead singer of the "Swinging Crowns Band." He joined the First Baptist Church in Groveland at an early age, and later joined St. Mary's Missionary Baptist Church in the early 70's, where again he expressed his gift of song by becoming a member of Choir #2. Robert was married to the late Marjorie Lamar. He loved to fish and play cards and enjoyed his family and friends. He can be remembered for always gathering the family on Sundays to sing "The Family Prayer" before church.
