Ronald “Julian” Valentine was the 8th child born to Henrietta Nee Gilbert and Richard Valentine, in Lagoon, Dominica, West Indies. From the age of 5 through 15, Julian attended the Portsmouth St. John’s School. Then at age 16, Julian began his first job as a construction worker/apprentice. Even while working in the field of construction, Julian was fascinated with sailing since he practically lived 16 years on a beachfront. Julian eventually enlisted as a sailor man visiting neighboring islands, where he experienced several exciting adventures. In 1977, Julian migrated to the United States to join his siblings and to start a new life in New York City. Julian’s love for the ocean continued and led him to his first job at the Flushing World Mariner in Flushing, New York repairing vessels.
