



Sister Rosemary Davis

April 14, 1952 - February 18, 2023

Rosemary Davis was born April 14, 1952 in Notasulga, Alabama to, James Ealy and Ella Potts. She graduated from Phyllis Wheatley High School in 1970. After high school, she continued her education at Orlando Vocational Technical School, earning her certification in Floral Design. She would go on to use her talent and love of floral design to decorate weddings and celebrations for friends and family.

Rosemary received Christ while attending St. Elizabeth Holiness Church, where she would also meet her future husband, Bishop Ronny Davis. They were married on June 9, 1973 in Apopka, Florida. Their union produced three children, Samuel, Sylvia, and Jaquelyn. In 1982, Rosemary followed her husband's calling into leadership and became the First Lady of the Lighthouse Tabernacle of Prayer in Apopka, Florida. They would then go on to continue the Lord's work in the organization's headquarter church in Jamaica, New York.

Rosemary was preceded in death by both of her parents James Ealy and Ella Elder (Apopka, FI). Her sister, Johnnie Mae Ligon; and her brother, Richard Elder (Atlanta, Georgia).
