On March 11, 1971, Ruby was united in holy matrimony to Reverend Leroy Hendrix. Reverend Hendrix was the pastor of Bethel Missionary Baptist Church in Winter Park, Florida for 38 years.

Ruby was a product of Seminole County Schools. She was a dedicated educator, and her career spanned over 32 years. Ruby was selected as Seminole County Public School's first African American "Teacher of the Year".

Ruby was a soldier for the Lord. She was an active member of Bethel Baptist Church, Winter Park, Florida for over 36 years. 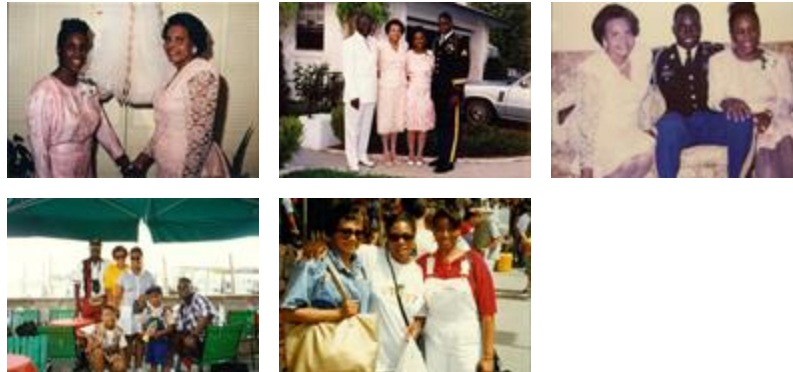
