Sarah Frances Slaughter was born August 13, 1936, in Brooksville, Georgia, to Callie and Fred McCrary. Sarah worked as a Retail Clerk and a Foodservice Supervisor in the hospital in Miami, Florida, for many years. She retired from Marshalls Department Store after a long career of dedicated service.

Sarah met and married Robert H. Slaughter in 1966. He was the absolute love of her life. They were blissfully married for 59 years, until his passing in January of 2024.

Sarah loved the Lord deeply and was a long-time member of New Jerusalem Primitive Baptist Church in Miami, Florida, under the leadership of Reverend Kenneth Duke.
