Uncle Junior career started out farming in Georgia an early age of nine years old. He excelled at farming to such an extent that a white female landowner offered to sell Solon Senior some property for Uncle Junior to really profit from his hard labor. According to Uncle Junior, Solon Senior offered to buy the property if, Uncle Junior would produce him a good crop. The Great crop was produced, but Solon Senior took the season profits and squandered it on whiskey and wild street life. This was the end of farming career.

Uncle moved to Florida and found orange picking was much better career. He did not have to wait until season end to realize a profit. He also worked as a

Watermelon contractor. From his hard labor he built four houses and developed mechanical skills to repair all his equipment from Automobiles to total Truck repairs.
