### The Life

Harvey L. Marshall, Sr. was born in Bellefontaine, Mississippi, on March 6, 1934, to the late Obediah and Vera Marshall. With only an eighth-grade education from Webster County School District, a young Harvey Marshall was forced into the field of work as a young field hand in rural Mississippi. Harvey later enlisted in the United States Army, where he served and was stationed in Germany. After serving his military duties abroad and receiving an honorable discharge, Harvey moved to Eatonville, Florida. Harvey was married to the former Luewill Wilson, a proud member of Malone Memorial COGIC. Those who knew him recognized him as a guitar-picking, quartet-singing preacher.
