He further pursued a degree in Law at the same college but was unable to complete the needed courses to secure a Law Degree due to declining health conditions.

He came to Orange County to live after leaving college. In 2001, he earned an Associate Degree in Business at Florida Metropolitan University.

He connected himself with New Hope Missionary Baptist Church, where he became a member of the Male Chorus. Singing was one of the ways he could express himself at church. He loved being a regular church attender.

Trent had a passion for singing, dancing, and collecting jewelry. He spent time working as an industrial worker and in food service.

Trent was preceded in death by his father, Theodore Bolen, his mother, Lille M. Rigsbee, his sister, Renee Bolen, his grandmothers Lillian Iverson and Lucille Johnson, his son, Eric Bruner and his Stepfather, Haywood Rigsbee.
