Vertis Mae Daniels was born April 18, 1940, in Sumter, Georgia to, Reverend John Clark, Sr. and Estella Jones-Clark. Vertis was a member of Vineville Baptist Church in Macon, Georgia for many years. While there, she was a songstress in the choir. She began her career in baking as a cake and pastry baker at Grants Pastry Shop in Macon, Georgia.
