



Vonshelle Davis Prioleau

June 26, 1965 - August 22, 2014

Edna was blessed with the joy of motherhood with the arrival of Vonshelle Jarmain on June 26, 1965. What a beautiful baby! She was raised in an atmosphere of pure love. Not only did she receive this from Edna, but from her father William Kendrick, grandmother Rosa B. Davis, godmother Eva Holt, other relatives and friends.

Strong Christian values and morals were instilled in Vonshelle at an early age. She was baptized by the late Reverend F. E. Wilder of Bethlehem Missionary Church. She was very active in all phases of the Youth Department, locally, state wide and nationally. In later years she united with Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church, Eatonville, Florida, Reverend Willie C Barnes Pastor. There she continued to serve and be a witness for the Lord. She was active in the Young Adult Ministry, sang with the Voices of Praise and attended Bible Study. Her faithfulness and commitment to her church, but most of all to God were a testimony of the life she lived.

Vonshelle attended Orange County Public Schools and excelled throughout her elementary, middle and high school years. In 1983 she graduated from West Orange High School, as well as being a Walt Disney World Cast Member. She began her career with Orange County as a Corrections Officer in the Orange County Jail later transferring to the Work Release Center. In her final position she served as a Community Corrections Officer with the

Alternative Community Service Department, retiring in 2007. Vonshelle also attended Valencia Community College obtaining an Associates of Science Degree in Criminal Technology in 2001.

On June 15, 1991 Vonshelle and Ronell Prioleau were united in holy matrimony. Their union was made complete with the birth of Chad Victor. Vonshelle saw Chad as the “apple of her eye” and she loved him unconditionally. She saw to it that he was given the best she could provide in loving care, spiritual nourishment and material comforts. She was also devoted to her mother and family putting their interests first. The love and bond she shared with Edna was unsurmountable, a love that only a mother and daughter could share. No task was too large or too small for one another. It was all because of love and respect.

She loved to travel, shop, (clothes, she was Miss Fashion), cook, (Publix and Winn Dixie will probably go out of business now) fine dining and the abundant life God promised. Vonshelle’s spirit was one of giving and sharing. She invested her many talents into every broadening, good work she could find. She loved people and sought to help them; she knew the true meaning of love and friendship and never counted the cost of loyalty.

During Vonshelle’s latter years God allowed her faith to be tested. There were times when others would have given up, but she kept fighting and holding on to her faith. 1 Corinthians 15:58 reads: “Therefore my brethren, be ye steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.” HER FAITH NEVER WAVERED!

On Friday night August 22, 2014, Vonshelle quietly slipped away with the assurance of 2 Timothy 4:6-8 “For I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand. I have fought a good fight, I have finished my

course, I have kept the faith. Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only but unto all them also that love His appearing.”
