William Barrington was born October 31, 1929. He was the seventh child of Jesse Barrington, Sr. and Priscilla Barrington of Jefferson County, Florida (Monticello). William accepted Christ at an early age and joined St. Rilla Missionary Baptist Church. William received an 8th grade education at St. Rilla Missionary Baptist Church. He was allowed to help his father farm the land on the family homestead because four of his brothers were already in the Army.

William live in Orlando, Eatonville, Sanford and Monticello, Florida. During this time, he was a member of Bethlehem Baptist Church Orlando, under the leadership of the late Rev. James Smith and Rev. L.W. Wilson. He was also a member of Freewill Holiness Church Apopka, the late Rev. James MacFarland, pastor. Once he returned to Monticello, Florida he rejoined St. Rilla Missionary Baptist Church under Pastor James Mack. William loved to sing. While living in Eatonville, he was a member of the Eatonville Male Chorus and sang in choirs of every church he attended. When visiting Orlando, he would attend Southside Church of Christ with his grand daughters. He loved the preaching, fellowship and acapella music that was being sung there. William loved reading the Bible and having Bible discussions with anyone he talked to. William was also a previous member of the Lake Hall Masonic Lodge #33 of Winter Park, Florida.

William lived a prosperous life. He was a sporty dresser with his own unique style. William always enjoyed planting and watching things grow. No matter where he lived, he had a garden. Additionally, he loved to cook. He owned Barrington Construction Company in the late 1960's, which included carpentry. He worked for Hubbard Construction Company for many years and retired from the City of Sanford in 2003.

He is preceded in death by his daughter, Mary Elizabeth Barrington Knight; parents, Jesse Sr. and Priscilla Barrington; brothers, Jesse Jr., Whitfield, Eddie, James and Wilbert; sister Rosebud Barrington Wilson.
