



William Jasper Rolle

July 27, 1931 - April 17, 2023

William J. Rolle was born on July 27, 1931, in Miami, Florida to the late Samuel P. and Violet B. Rolle. He was the second son born to a family of six children.

William received his education in the Dade County School System in Miami, FL. He played the saxophone in the Dorsey Senior High School's Marching and Symphonic Bands.

After graduating high school, William enlisted in the United States Army in April 1948 and served three Tours of Duty until July 1968. During William's enlistments, he served as a 11C4B Inf Ind Fire Crewman. He also completed Drill Sergeant School and CBR Training. During his tenure, William received several commendations to include The National Defense Service Medal W/1 OLC, The Army Commendation Medal, The Good Conduct Medal Bronze W/3 as well as four (4) Letters of Commendation.

Retiring from the Military in 1968, William began his career with the United States Postal Service where he maintained employment from 1968 to July 1989.

On September 2, 1978, William was united in marriage to Shirley Herts. To this union, a daughter, Nichol L. Rolle, was born. The family united with True

Vine Baptist Church in San Jose, CA. William was ordained as a deacon at True Vine. He served as chairman of the Trustee Board. He also served on the usher board, the male chorus and with the men's ministry.

After relocating to Orlando, FL, William united with the New Covenant Baptist Church of Orlando (NCBC). William was actively involved and served with several ministries at NCBC including the Finance Ministry, Choir, Security Ministry, Sunday School, Men's Ministry, Silver Strands and District Three, until his health began to fail.

William leaves to cherish his precious memories, his loving wife of 44 years, Shirley Rolle; two daughters: Loretta Collins, (Phillip) and Nichol L. Rolle; two granddaughters: Shaphonia Tribble of Charlotte, NC and Kamiah Rose Stewart, Orlando, FL; Brother-in-law, Dr. George Herts; and many other family members and a host of longtime friends.

William's memory and legacy will always be one of a loving, lovable, wise, and God-Fearing man.
