Willie Mae Burden was born in Cheraw, South Carolina to parents, Willie J. Thomas and Francis E. Harris and her parents birthed from their hearts John W. Smith and Sarah F. Smith on October 16, 1955.

Willie Mae attended Chesterfield, County Schools and graduated from Cheraw High School in 1973. After High school, she entered the work field at Saconey Manufacturing Plant where her passion for sewing began.

On September 26, 1976, her first true love, Nosakhere K. Harris was born, and all who knew her, knew that her love for her son was admirable. It was love at first sight!
