Willie Albert Shingles was born September 16, 1945 in Edison, Georgia to the late Carrie Goines Shingles and Ike Shingles.

As a youth, he attended Edison Elementary and graduated from Henry T. Singleton High School in 1964.

During his lifetime, he worked in the agricultural, heating and cooling industries.

At an early age, he joined Turner Baptist Church and developed a love of singing while participating in the Senior Choir. Once settled in Florida, he became a member of Mt. Pleasant Missionary Baptist Church in Orlando where he was an active member.

He was always whistling a tune, happy-go-lucky, and full of fun. Wherever he was, laughter was near because he was notorious for telling jokes. Willie Albert loved music; the Blues was his favorite genre, and Johnny Taylor was his favorite Blues artist. He enjoyed playing cards with his wife and friends in Orlando.

Willie Albert migrated to Florida and met his “best friend” and the love of his life, Patricia Shingles. They celebrated their commitment to one another in

2008 and remained married for the remainder of his days. When he returned to Edison for visits, he would jokingly announce his arrival by saying, "A man is in town, better known as "Rawhide!" One of his greatest joys was visiting his family and friends in Edison for a good time to reminisce.

He was preceded in death by his beloved parents: Carrie Goines Shingles and Ike Shingles; son, Rickey Ceasar; sisters: Gertha Willis and Nell Taylor; and brothers: Lewis Shingles and Thomas Shingles.
