Zavier was one of Keith's (owner) best drivers. While on the job, Zavier sustained a brain injury during an altercation that was not reported in a timely manner for prompt medical assistance. It was during this time of increasing oxygen deprivation to the brain that eventually rendered him unable to care for himself. Now, here we are almost 5 years later saying good bye.
